Checklist for Muslim women to consider before marriage

Islamic marriage contract: Understand the concept of Mahr (dower or Maskavi) and negotiate a fair amount Discuss including a delegated right of divorce (talaq tafwid) in the contract Legal considerations: Decide between an Islamic marriage only or both Islamic and civil marriage Understand the implications of marrying in or out of community of property Consider the legal status of Muslim marriages in South Africa **Financial rights:** Understand your right to separate property in Islamic law Discuss expectations regarding nafaqah (maintenance) from your husband Consider how to protect any assets you bring into the marriage Future planning: Discuss views on polygyny and consider including relevant clauses in the marriage contract Understand the concept of iddah and its implications for divorce **Divorce considerations:** Understand different types of Islamic divorce (nikāh, faskh, khula'). Learn about your rights in case of divorce, including mu'tah (consolatory gift) and submitting claims for arrears maintenance.
